Event	Demolition Derby	Balloon Round-Up
Ages	4-7 year olds	2-3 year olds
Object	Balloons are attached to the outside of vehicles. Drivers will try and pop balloons on the other vehicles.	Run over and pop as many balloons as possible during the allowed time.
Vehicle	Battery operated Power Wheel type vehicles only. No 4-wheeler / tractor style vehicles, legs must be inside. Ride-IN not ride-on.	Any Power Wheel type vehicle is allowed (including tractor and 4-wheeler styles)
Safety	Helmets must be worn. Bicycle helmets are permitted. Seatbelts are recommended. NO PASSENGERS.	Helmets are recommended. Drivers must be able to steer by themselves. No passengers.
Battery	6 or 12-volt only	
Register	Registration will close at 10:30 the morning of the show. Pre-registration is helpful in separating age groups if needed. Please notify Ashley if you plan on participating but are unable to pre-register.	
Check-In	Before 10:30AM on event day. Vehicles should be brought into fair grounds through Gate A or B and immediately parked in/beside the Coldwell Banker Realty Entertainment Pavilion.

Additional Rules for Demolition Derby:

- 1. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. (zip ties, duct tape or other flexible product)
- 2. Vehicle alterations:
 - a. Tires-stock only. May cover with duct tape to prevent cracking or breaking. No screws in tires, no chains, etc...
 - b. Motors must remain stock. Batteries -NOTHING larger than a 12-volt lawn & garden battery. NO CAR BATTERIES
 - c. **Decorative changes only** can be made to the Power Wheel to make it look like a derby car, however; there can be no reinforcement added.
- 3. At all times remember this is for kids!! Don't add something that could cause them to be disqualified. You could have a disappointed child if not allowed to run.
- 4. A fair committee member will attach the balloons. The object is to pop balloons. The last one left with a balloon is the winner. There will be a time limit for each group, if more than 1 vehicle with balloons intact it will be declared a tie.
- 5. If a child gets out of the power wheel during the event, that child is out of the event--for safety reasons.
- 6. Vehicles are to be checked in the morning of the Derby from 10-11am. Vehicles will be "impounded" until event time. Bring cars to the Entertainment Pavilion near Gate A. After the event is the guardian's responsibility to remove the vehicle from the Fair Grounds. The fair will not be held responsible for any vehicles that are left on the premises.
- 7. Pre-registration is recommended. If unable to fully pre-register please call, text, or email the information to Ashley. Registration for the events will end at 10:30AM Saturday August 10th. A parent/guardian must sign the registration prior to a child participating.
